## RESOLUTION

**Whereas**, the purpose of the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District (the "District") is for the preservation and conservation of its groundwater in accordance with Chapter 36 of the Texas Water Code.

Whereas, the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") plans to begin the operation of the District including creating bylaws, policies, budgets, contracts, hiring personnel, and opening and furnishing offices.

**Whereas,** it is necessary the District borrow to fund its operations until adequate revenue from collection of property taxes is received,

Now, therefore Be It Resolved, the Officers of the Board, being the President, Vice-President, Secretary, and Treasurer are hereby authorized on behalf of the District to borrow from The First National Bank of Eagle Lake up to One Hundred Thousand dollars (\$100,000) at an interest rate of five and one-half percent per annum and due eleven months twenty-one days from the date of the loan and to sign a commitment note for this amount and all other necessary documents.

**Be It Further Resolved,** each officer's signature shall be required on said commitment note and loan documents.
