Regular Meeting Minutes

May 20, 2026

The Directors of the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District met on May 20, 2026 at 7:00 p.m. at the District Office located at 910 Milam Street, Columbus, Texas.

President Labay called the meeting to order at 7:27 p.m.

Meeting minutes dated March 18, 2026, were approved by unanimous consent.

GM Weishuhn gave an update on violations by Maral Drilling and Zavala Drilling and an investigation into reported annual water usage by Alleyton Resource Company.

GM Weishuhn reported on a Public Information Request received via email. The request was forwarded to legal counsel, Monique Norman.

GM Weishuhn gave an update on two grant applications, The Agricultural Water Conservation Grant and the Groundwater Research Grant. The District should receive a determination on June 25, 2026.

GM Weishuhn provided details on four replacement well applications that he recently approved.

The Board discussed potential future developments in Colorado County and the associated impact on aquifer levels and groundwater availability. GM Weishuhn will contact county officials to discuss the county's position on water intensive projects.

GM Weishuhn reported that the next Region K meeting will be held June 24, 2026, at the LCRA Service Center in Austin. The public may comment on the 2031 Regional Water Plan for 30 days past the meeting date.

GM Weishuhn reported that public hearings on the proposed DFC will be required for GMA15 members. Colorado County's DFC hearing will be held July 15, 2026, at the District office. Public notice will be published in the Colorado County Citizen in early June, as well as at the County Annex and the District office. There will be a 90-day public comment period.

GM Weishuhn reported on the following:

- Drought Update
- Water Well Monitoring Report
- Highland Lake Levels

GM Weishuhn presented the 2026 Q1 Investment Report. Director Lanier moved to approve the report. The motion was seconded by Director Pavliska and carried unanimously.

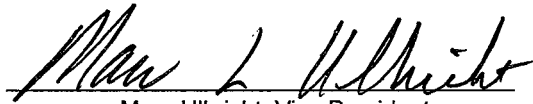

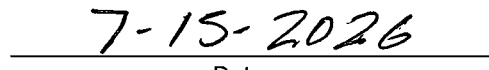
GM Weishuhn provided an update on recent speaking engagements and outlined his upcoming presentation schedule.
