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ORDER OFFICIALLY ADOPTING THE TAX RATE FOR TAX YEAR 2013 OF THE COLORADO COUNTY GROUNDWATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District (the District), a governmental agency and entity, a body corporate and politic, and a political subdivision of the State of Texas, by official action taken at a public meeting of the Board of Directors (the Board) of the District held and conducted on September 18, 2013, has adopted a 2014 Budget for the District's 2014 fiscal year of January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014;

WHEREAS, THE PROPOSED Tax Rate for the District of \$ 0.0145 per \$ 100 of value for Tax year 2013 is lower than the Tax Rate adopted by the Board of the Tax Year 2012.

NOW THEREFORE, KNOW ALL PERSONS AND ENTITIES THAT THE AFORESAID BOARD OF DIRECTORS HEREBY MAKES, APPROVES and ADOPTS this ORDER, and said Board of Directors of the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District by the Order hereby officially sets, approves and adopts the Tax Rate of \$ 0.0145 per \$ 100 of value for Tax Year 2013 of the Colorado County Groundwater Conservation District.
